## **SHE LEADS Project:**

SHE LEADS aims at promoting social entrepreneurship, cooperative model, and cooperative enterprise principals as effective approaches to overcome some of the social and economic challenges Palestinian refugees in Southern West Bank face on a daily basis, to support their socioeconomic conditions and to maximize their contributions to wellbeing and development for themselves and their communities.



SHE LEADS project is implemented by Ibtikar for Empowerment and Social Entrepreneurship in partnership with Strengthening the Influence of Palestinian Refugees on their living Conditions PART II programme implemented by the GIZ on behalf of the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ).

Creating Support Groups, Fostering Entrepreneurship



SHE LEADS has achieved remarkable milestones in empowering refugee women, enabling them to take charge of their futures and create a positive impact in their communities. One of the key outcomes of the project has been the establishment of two support groups, comprising women who have not only benefited from the project but have also showcased their entrepreneurial spirit by developing future initiatives.

# The Dheisheh Refugee Camp Group

Driven by a vision of empowerment, has generated two exciting initiative ideas. First, they aim to create a women-led safe space within the Dheisheh camp.

This safe space will provide a nurturing environment where women can come together, share experiences, and access essential resources and support.

It will serve as a hub for empowerment, skill-building, and community, development, fostering solidarity among refugee women.

Second, the Dheisheh refugee camp group has conceived the "Palestinian Puppets" project.

This innovative initiative focuses on designing and sewing puppets that embody the traditional Thob (Palestinian dress) from different Palestinian villages. By showcasing these puppets, the project aims to preserve and celebrate the rich cultural heritage of Palestinian communities.

Moreover, this project has the potential to create job opportunities for 16 women from Dheisheh and Al-Aroob refugee camps, empowering them with valuable skills and a source of income.

Al-Azzeh and Aida Refugee Camps Group

The second support group has envisioned the establishment of the "Rehanna Cooperative for Agricultural Production and Processing" in Al-Azzeh refugee camp, Bethlehem.

This agricultural initiative aims to form a cooperative that engages in various aspects of agricultural production and processing. Refugee women will have the opportunity to actively participate in farming activities, such as crop cultivation and livestock raising.

Additionally, the cooperative will explore value-addition and processing of agricultural products, contributing to the local economy and improving the livelihoods of the women involved.
