

# The Role of the Family in Addressing Cyber Blackmail Issues



## Awareness and Prevention

- Strengthening self-confidence and self-respect.
- The family is the first source of awareness about different forms of blackmail (financial, sexual, emotional).
- Developing communication skills and the ability to defend one's rights.
- Providing a safe space for discussion and offering practical examples.



## Understanding and Accepting Mistakes

- Reinforcing the belief that mistakes are opportunities for learning.
- Understanding the victim's feelings without blame or criticism.
- Providing emotional support to help rebuild self-confidence.



## Support and Assistance

- Considering the victim's needs and providing appropriate care and support.
- Ensuring complete confidentiality when handling the incident.
- Coordinating the search for help with the victim, without pressuring them.



## Taking Technical and Legal Action

- Activating security and protection software on devices.
- Securing the family's electronic devices.
- Collecting evidence to present in legal proceedings.
- Guiding the victim to the appropriate legal authorities for support.
